Directions - Summarized From RULES OF ELECTION (PETITION)

One (1) member is to be elected from among Annuitant Members of the PABF. The petition for each such candidate must be signed by twenty-five (25) persons duly qualified to vote for the Trustee representing Annuitant Members. Petitions will be available December 31, 2025 through 4:30pm on January 9, 2026, at www.chipabf.org or in the PABF Office, 221 N. LaSalle Street, Room 1626. The petitions of candidates must be filed in-person during the period of January 5, 2026 beginning at 9:00 A.M. through January 9, 2026 at 4:30 P.M., at the PABF Office. The sufficiency of any petitions may be challenged in writing January 12-13, 2026. Any candidate may withdraw his or her petition on or before January 20, 2026. The sufficiency of all nominating petitions shall be passed upon by the Retirement Board at a meeting to be held in January 2026. No candidate's name shall be printed on the ballot unless he or she has filed a passed upon petition.
