

Sergeant John Lally

John Lally has served with the Chicago Police Department for 25 years, beginning his career on August 27, 2001.

Following probation, he was assigned as a patrol officer to the 15th District, where he served until 2008. In 2008, John made Detective and spent the next eight years assigned to Area Three and Area North, working in Violent Crimes and Homicide. In 2016, he was promoted to the rank of Sergeant. John has spent the majority of that time in the Detective Division, working in Area North, Area Four, and the Investigative Response Team, where he was assigned in 2021 and has remained since.

John is the current Trustee to the Chicago Police Pension Fund representing members of the rank of Sergeant, a position he has held since being first elected in August 2020. John was re-elected in 2023 and is again seeking re-election in October.

John spent his undergraduate studies at the University of Notre Dame and St. Xavier's University, receiving a degree in Business Administration from SXU. John is also a graduate of the Certified Financial Planning program from DePaul University.
